Deane has been named as a Para Athlete in the NZ Team for the **Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games**.



## **Umpire's Corner**

#### **Question (LXXXVIII)**

What is foot-faulting? What are the umpire's powers if foot-faulting occurs?

#### **Answer**

If, before delivery, a player does not stand with one foot fully on the mat and if, at the moment of delivering the jack or bowl, a player does not have part of one foot on or above the mat. (Law 7.1)

Give the player a warning in the presence of the skip, then the next time it happens stop the bowl and declare it dead. (Law 8.1, 8.2)

In the above scenario b) what if the umpire is unable to stop the bowl?
