Umpire's Corner

Question (LXXXVIII)

- a) What is foot-faulting?
- b) What are the umpire's powers if foot-faulting occurs?

Answer

- a) If, before delivery, a player does not stand with one foot fully on the mat and if, at the moment of delivering the jack or bowl, a player does not have part of one foot on or above the mat. (Law 7.1)
- b) Give the player a warning in the presence of the skip, then the next time it happens stop the bowl and declare it dead. (Law 8.1, 8.2)

Question (LXXXIX)

In the above scenario b) what if the umpire is unable to stop the bowl?

Answer


If it has not been possible to stop the bowl and it disturbs the head, the opponent must choose whether to:

- 8.3.1 replace the head
- 8.3.2 leave the head as altered or
- 8.3.3 declare the end dead

Question (XC)

After an umpire has been called to check the legality of a mat it is found to be short of the required two metres from the ditch. What happens next?
