New Laws of Bowls

Thanks to **David Conroy** for this **summary**.

April 1st sees the introduction of a <u>revised book of the laws</u> of our sport. This has produced a certain amount of **consternation** that **old habits** can now receive a **harsh penalty** – **NOT SO!** There are A number of changes just involve **sensible re-wording**, but a **few** must be regarded as **notable changes**.

42.2 Duties of a marker

This section should be read by all markers. The only change is the addition of a requirement to **check that the mat is on the centre line**. Most of us would do this anyway. (Note that it has always been a requirement to challenge a short jack – now 42.2.3)

26.3 No further play

Common sense again, but now a **requirement to stop playing** in a knock-out match when it becomes mathematically **impossible to win**.

29.1.4 Out of turn

New law to cover the situation where bowls are played out of turn. **In singles**, if **both players have played** a bowl **that order continues** for the remainder of the end.

5.1.1 and 29.3.1.2 Moving surfaces.

Now you can have trial ends and **change to a different set** of bowls if you are moved from a **natural** surface **to** an **artificial** one.

37.1.3 and 37.1.5.3 Picking up Bowls

Rumours abound that picking up a bowl can cost you the match. WHOA! These new laws cover activity on the rink of play.

They cover a **DELIBERATE** action to gain advantage on your rink.

- 37.1.3 covers a player **deliberately stopping** a bowl delivered by **their team member**.
- 37.1.5.3 covers a player **deliberately lifting a bowl** at rest on their rink to allow their team's member's bowl **to pass**.

Ever see either happen? I doubt it. But if it does – the **match is forfeited** immediately. So don't do it. You can still **pick up and replace** or **roll back and forth** to allow a **neighbour's bowl** through without a penalty – but best **not touch a bowl** that might be in the **count**.

And **markers MUST STOP** a neighbour's bowl if it **might disturb** their head. **Markers MUST NEVER touch bowls** on their rink unless told to by the players.
