Spotlight on Graeme Rees

Graeme is a **wonderful bowler** and a **National class coach**. He has also held executive roles including **Secretary** and **Vice President**. He tells us a bit more about his life.

I'm **Canterbury** born and bred and wouldn't live anywhere else.

I've been **married to Kare**n for **34 years** and have a **son Owen** who is now 21 and studying at Canterbury University.

I've been a **Credit Controller** all my career starting at the **Housing Corporation** when I left school. My first role was a tough gig **collecting debt** from vacated state tenants.

After many years in the lending division Rogernomics caught up with me and I was made redundant. I moved to **BOC**, the **gas company**, and completed another **13 years** in Credit Control before **moving to** a Credit role with **MYOB** leading a team of 10 in Australia and New Zealand. I'm still with MYOB **working 4 days a week**, they are a great company to work for



I **started** playing bowls at **Morrison Ave** as a **14 year old.** I only got to be a member after an executive vote (passed by one vote) because they thought I was **too young!** I moved to **Burnside in 1986** and have played at the **best bowls club** ever since. Over the years I have found myself playing with some top players and have picked up **7 club titles**. My greatest playing achievement on the green was winning the **Canterbury Pairs** with **Pat Bonham**.

On **9 second greens** and **high temperatures** the team didn't achieve as well as 2 years earlier, but they learnt how to cope with a **difficult environment**.

Personal Development coaching opportunities, by way of a **scholarship in 2007**, took me to **Malaysia** to learn from their bowls environment and to **Brisbane** to spend a week at the Australia Cricket Institute of sport. I'm also part of the **Kia Manawanui satellite group** for the next 12 months. This is a future-focused coach development initiative designed by **HPSNZ** to **support coaches** who are working with the **next cycle of performance athletes**. Included in the group are a Netball, Equestrian, Basketball, Table Tennis, Para Alpine and Surfing coach. A very exciting time ahead.

I now have a **role with Bowls NZ** working one day a week as the **National Coach Development Lead.** Over the next 6 months I have **8 trips planned** around NZ, coaching coaches.

My other interests include going to the Gym, Philately and watching Rugby/Cricket.

Five years off retirement and life doesn't slow down. I am looking forward to **playing more bowls** and being involved in **coaching at all levels**.
