Etiquette and 'possession of the rink'

Anyone watching the great **Peter Belliss** in Otago might have just heard his sotto voce saying '....doesn't understand mat etiquette'. What does that mean?



As soon as a **bowl stops** at the head **ownership** of the mat **transfers** - in that split second. **Etiquette** requires that the **rink is clear** for the **next bowler** to play their shot.



Far too often an **opponent** can be seen **ambling** back or gazing at the head from halfway.



If you choose to follow your bowl you must be behind the head when it stops (Law 13). Otherwise you must be behind the mat.



If you are **changing ends** but not next to bowl you should be behind the mat by the time your **opponent is ready** to play.



Dawdling is bad etiquette.

Spotlight on Graham Tate

After 88 years of fun and adventure Graham shares a bit about his life.

Having failed University Entrance at **Mt Albert Grammar School**, Graham worked on 5 different farms as a **Rural Field Cadet** before completing courses at **Massey** and **Lincoln** Colleges. He was the first in his family to graduate from university and ended up with a **Masters** degree.

Graham **married Marion** in 1958 and they are still together **65 years** later.

Graham then spent 5 years **as a rural appraiser** helping to **settle** returning **WW2 soldiers** and **civilian** ballotees onto farms in 3 different provinces. He followed this with 5 years running a commercial **valuation** and **farmer advisory** service in **Winton**



He moved into **academia in 1968**, first as a **lecturer** and then a **head of department** at **Lincoln** College (later Lincoln University). He remained there until **1990**.

Graham then became a New Zealand **VSA Field Representative** for **Southern Africa** and was based in **Zimbabwe for two years**. After that he set up as an **international consultant** specialising in **change** and **project management**. Overall he has worked in **20 countries** and has spent time living in South Korea, Thailand, Bhutan, Zimbabwe and Fiji. He counts himself fortunate to have **visited** more than **60 countries** in many different parts of the world.

When a **2005** shoulder injury took him out of most sports, he joined the **Papanui** Chartered Bowling Club where he won the **Junior Singles** and was a member of a **Junior Fours** that won the **Centre Championship**.

Graham became an accredited **bowls coach** in his third year. He very much **enjoyed coaching** until loss of hearing caused him to retire 13 years later.

Since transferring to Burnside in **2010**, he has enjoyed coaching and being a member of two teams winning the **Burnside Fours Championships**. He has found the **walking groups** to be a great way of socialising.

Graham now describes himself as a very deaf **88 year old** who cannot correctly distinguish words amid background noise. He is **extremely grateful** to belong to such an **inclusive group** of people making a great game **accessible** and **enjoyable** for all.
