Umpire's Niggle Corner

Here is another of **David Conroy's** occasional articles.

Placing the jack.

Often the **conditions of play** will specify **special rules** that apply just to that tournament or competition. One such rule allows an **incorrectly delivered** jack to be **placed by the opposition**.

However, in the **absence** of any special rules the **Laws** of the Sport of Bowls **must apply**. An **incorrectly delivered** jack **must be sent back** for the opposing team to deliver. If the **second attempt fails** the **original bowler** gets to **place** the **mat** where they like and the **jack** goes on the **2 metre mark**.
