Doug joined Burnside Bowling Club in **1984** and had successes, including being the Club **Junior Singles Champion** and skipping the **Junior Fours** to a win.

In his many years on the **match committee**, Doug introduced several **new competitions** including **the sixes**, where teams of 6 play **pairs and fours** one day and then **two triples** the next. In those days before computers it was a **huge job** to prepare the **draws** and **cards** and manage the **results** for three greens ... **all by hand!** Doug is really proud that this competition has become a **regular event** for the club.

Now retired and living at **Ngaio Marsh Village**, Doug celebrated his **90**th birthday a couple of weeks ago. There was a **big party**! He has **4 grandchildren** and **6 great grandchildren**. He is very pleased to have introduced his son-in-law **Allan Vernel** to the club (so are we!).
