Fifteen years ago, **13-year-old Tayla Bruce** was **persuaded** by her **parents** to go with them to watch some lawn **bowls** at the **2008 World Bowls Championships** at Burnside Bowling Club.

A keen **netballer**, Tayla was fascinated to see **younger players** representing their countries at this international event.

She was particularly taken with 17-year-old Kelsey Cottrell who was playing singles and triples for the Australian Jackaroos team. She avidly followed Kelsey's games during the event and was hoping to meet her. Late one freezing afternoon, she was excited to get a photo (right) and autograph at Bowls Papanui (another host club for the event).



It was **this big event** that **sparked Tayla's interest** in the game. **Seeing younger people** out there playing at **such a high level** provided **inspiration** of what could be achieved and **encouraged** her to **start playing**. It wasn't long before she had **ditched netball** and was the proud owner of her **first set of bowls** - turquoise Taylor Vector VS size one - with **big dreams** of maybe one day playing for New Zealand.



And of course **she achieved** that dream! Among her **many successes** being **two bronze medals** at the **Commonwealth games** (left) and taking out the **World Champion of Champion Singles** last year.

Spotlight on Mort Young

(Sadly Mort died a few days before this publication.)

Mort Young was one of our **life members.** He was instrumental in **establishing** and/or **running** many of our **tournaments** including Festival Bowls, Medley Triples, Mixed Pairs Championship, and the Gala Pairs He was also an **international umpire** and officiated at many **international events**. He was a **club captain**, **sheriff**, and the **founding editor** of the Hotline. Here is some more about his life.

Mort's **early days** had their problems mainly through the **passing** of **both parents** at an early age. His father died when he was 12 years old and his mother when he was 17.

Mort attended primary school at the **Andersons Bay School** in Dunedin followed by four years at the Rectory at **Timaru Boys High School**. He really enjoyed his time at TBHS where he managed to claim **athletic track records** in the junior 440 and 880 yds. These records were held at that time by **Pat Boot** who represented NZ at the 1936 Olympics.



His **working life** started with the clothing company of **Ross and Glendining** and after four years he joined **Lane Walker Rudkin** Ltd. At LWR he moved through the **sales ranks** to become **Branch Manager** and then **Divisional Sales Manager**. Mort then set up an independent company **LWR Leisurewear** and became the **Managing Director** of a successful company built around good people.

Around the time he joined LWR he **met Pauline** and they **married** when Pauline was **21** and Mort was **24** years old. He remembers Pauline's mother, **Joyce**, as a **fantastic lady** who treated him like a son.

They have **two girls** and **one son** and appreciate the support they have given them recently. They have **five grandchildren** and **six great grandchildren** - all doing very very well. **Abbey**, who is 14, has been selected for the **U16 New Zealand Water Polo Squad**, and **Finn**, at 16, is the **youngest hockey player** in the **premier division** in Canterbury.

Following his **retirement** from LWR, Mort's life has revolved around **bowls at Burnside** and **administration** at Burnside and **beyond**. He has found this to be a very rewarding period of his life. He was **club captain** for 8 years, established **many tournaments**, and organised the **club tracksuits**.

Mort became an **international umpire** and officiated in **numerous countries** including Australia, Malaysia, Wales, England, Scotland and South Africa. A highlight was **marking the World Men's Singles Final** at Fendalton in 2005. He also **officiated** at the **World Bowls** in 2008 and 2017, and the **Asia Pacific Championships** in 2007 and 2016.

Outside of bowls Mort and Pauline purchased a **holiday home** in **Arrowtown** which they owned for 17 years.

Mort looked back on his years with **much satisfaction** and recognised the **wonderful work** so many **new members** are doing. He said that he "thought **Burnside** was in **great shape** and was **proud** to be a **member**".
