Spotlight on Tony Bennett

Tony has recently resigned after being the **club's cleaner** for more than 17 **years**. He is also responsible for having made 80 of those **wonderful wooden carriers** for the club's bowls sets. Here is a bit about his fascinating life.

Tony was born in **1935** in **Sheffield** and started school there at the **outbreak of World War II**. Being an industrial city, Sheffield was a **prime target** for **German bombers**. In the winter of **1941-1942** he and his family emerged from an air raid shelter to find the roof blown off their home and all the windows and doors blown in. Searching in **bomb sites** for German curios to take to school was a normal pastime. His **best friend** Patrick and a younger brother found **an anti aircraft shell**, carried it home as a **souvenir** only for it to **explode**, killing them both. Difficult times indeed!

Tony started his working life with Andrews Toledo, a **steelworks** in Sheffield and became part of a team selected to process a new metal, **Titanium**, widely used in the **aerospace** industries. It was not realised at the time how important Titanium would become for **medical implants** (the only known element not to be rejected by the human body).



In the **post-war** era, thousands of people were **migrating** from **Europe** to countries in the Commonwealth and the United States. Having once met a Kiwi couple in a hotel in Bournemouth, Tony **applied for migration** to **New Zealand.**

At 22 he farewelled family and friends, and after a **sea voyage** of more than **5 weeks**, arrived in Wellington and then on to Christchurch. With its gardens, rivers and hills and wide streets, he found it a **huge contrast** to **industrial Sheffield**. He worked briefly for **P&D Duncan's** who manufactured farm equipment, and then for the **Union Steamship Company**.

After **two years** his commitment to the immigration service was over, but by now he was **happy in his life** in Christchurch, playing **golf**, learning to **fly** and meeting his **wife Jill**. Jill was also an English **immigrant** who came here for a job at **Ballantynes**. They have **two sons**. Stephen, a **canon** at **Canterbury Cathedral**, was originally an organist and once officiated at an **ANZAC service** at Whitehall and **Westminster Abbey**. Their younger son, **Tony**, was a chorister with the **National Youth Choir**, an excellent golfer and is now an **air traffic controller**.

In 1960, **Tony's parents** moved to **Christchurch**, and Tony and his **father** operated a **Blue Star Taxi** for 24 hours a day between them. Jill and Tony spent 10 years as **licensees** at **Warners Hotel** and then ventured into their own **sports and cycle business.** They then took over the **NZ Post franchise** at Ilam. Such a varied set of careers!

Tony had success as a **golfer** and **billiard** and **snooker** player. After his retirement he took up **bowls** and won the inaugural **Canterbury Junior Singles** title. However his **ambitions** were curtailed when he had a **serious run in** with a **billiard cue** at the **NZ Snooker Championships.** This eventuated in his **eye socket** now being **strengthened** with that miracle metal **titanium** he worked with in Sheffield as a youngster!

Now he is just **happy** to get out on **Burnside's beautiful greens** and hope to get a **bowl** somewhere **near** the jack.
