Executive Summary

Key points from the Executive meeting of **September 19**.

 The defibrillator has a new battery and a new home. It is still in the foyer on the same wall but is now positioned between the door to the women's locker room and the door to the office.



- Membership currently sits at 243 members (48 non-playing).

- Roof repairs: The Executive has approved urgent repair work
 that is needed on a section of the roof that has been causing
 longtime leaks by the upstairs trophy cabinet and downstairs back
 door.
- **Bathroom repairs:** A plumber has **fixed** some bathroom **leaks** and **replaced leaking taps** in the chiller area.
- All heat pumps have been serviced. The two older ones in the upstairs lounge require some additional work and this will be done.
