



INFORMATION FOR NEW MEMBERS

Coaching

Individual coaching is available on request at no charge by contacting one of Burnside's coaches (contact phone numbers are listed at the back of the programme booklet). Video analysis software, allowing a player's delivery to be captured on video and analyzed, is also available. Group coaching sessions will be offered and publicized as they are arranged.

Green Fee Players

Greens will be available (unless required for Club or Centre fixtures) to Non-Playing Members and Visitors for Casual Roll-ups for \$10.00pp Green Fee. This does not include Club Days or organised rollups. Money to be put in envelope provided and placed in Club Letterbox next to Office door. This is an opportunity for members to bring along family and friends to enjoy our facilities both on the green and in the Upstairs Lounge. Jacks and mats kept under the foyer stairwell. Sets of Club bowls are available. These are for use of prospective new bowlers or anyone coming in to the Club for roll-ups. All mats, jacks and Club bowls must be returned at completion of game.

Subscriptions

Due from 1st August and should be paid before the start of the season. Early payment of subscriptions would be appreciated. N.B. Members are reminded that the Executive has determined under Section 10.5 of the Club Constitution that members are not eligible to play in any Club or Centre events, if the annual subscription or any other moneys owing to the Club remain unpaid.

Centre Inter-Club Events

To assist the selectors with entering teams, a circular is sent out for members to indicate which events and on which days they are available for selection.

N.B. A Club Policy Statement on selection of teams for Centre events is displayed on the notice board in the Match Room. Teams selected will be placed on the Club web site during the week before the date of playing. Please indicate your availability by ticking your name early. If for any reason you subsequently find that you are unable to play on the date notify the selector IMMEDIATELY.

Local Inter-club and Club Only Events

Availability to play charts are placed in the Men's & Women's Match Rooms with a closing date clearly indicated. For further information on Club events and competitions and general items of interest, members should check all notice boards frequently. Entries for club events marked \bigstar can be made as above or by visiting the Tournaments tab on our web site and clicking on the appropriate event.

Under 5's

Competitions are programmed for first and second year players and Under 5's. All Club competitions are controlled by the Match Committee. Centre and Inter-Club teams are arranged by the Selectors.

Club Uniform

Men: Club shirt with plain colour black trousers or shorts, white jersey

Women: Club shirt with plain colour black trousers, ¾ pants, shorts, skirt or skort, black jersey.

Club Tracksuit: Can be worn when conditions warrant as part of the Club uniform. While we have supplies on hand, members will be offered a Club jacket, and over trouser. This clothing should be returned when the member leaves the club.

Correct Footwear: Heel-less with smooth soles.

Hats: Members are encouraged to wear a hat in club colours, suitable for UV protection.

Hoodie/Soft Jacket The approved green club hoodie/soft jacket may be worn at any time.

For Participants in all Interclub, Centre and National Fixtures – Team members must wear the same approved Club uniform (see above). Skips should remind team members of the correct attire.

For Club Tournaments – All Day –approved Club uniform. Half Day – Club shirt with sports trousers or shorts.

For Club Saturday Play - Approved Club uniform for <u>all</u> Club championships, Interclub friendly events and Club trophy events. Festival Bowls and organised Saturday Roll Ups may be played in mufti when indicated in the Programme Book or on the entry sheets.

For All Other Occasions Sunday to Friday – e.g. competition matches, midweek Club days, or evening games and casual play generally – neat standard of dress with the only specific requirement being correct footwear- see above. Club uniform may be worn if preferred.

For Club Championship matches - Club uniform should be worn in all Club Championship matches played on Saturdays and in Championship Finals. At the discretion of the Executive, when the occasion warrants it, Club uniform may be required for any day of the week for all players. This will normally be noted on the Club programme but if not then as much notice as possible will be given.

The Notice Board

On the exterior wall as you enter the grounds is for the allocation of rinks for Match Play. When you have arranged a game, enter the details on this board. On the day of Play, the Green Keeper will allocate your rink alongside your entry.

PLAY ONLY ON THE RINK NOMINATED.

Further, when coming for a roll-up always check which rinks have been allocated for match play, and if possible allow a free rink between you and any match.

The Green Superintendent and Green Keeper

Have complete control over green usage and will allocate the rinks to be played on. All players must play on the greens and rinks allocated.

Indoor Winter Bowls

Takes place in the downstairs Dining Room from May to September. 1.00 pm start Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Please arrive at 12.45 for a 1pm start.

See Secretary. Place name on the form in the match rooms and a locker will be allocated as soon as one becomes available.

Role of the Duty Team

Each interclub day the greens being used must be set up for play.

The green-keeper allocates rinks and these are set out on the TV screen by the dining room door.

Duty team members are asked to arrive early and work from the board.

- 1) Put out the mats and jacks for each rink
- 2) Put one of the "kitty in the ditch" markers i.e. the golf balls, behind the rink number at both ends.
- 3) Clean all the boards, set numbers to zero, and check that there is chalk available.
- 4) Chalk pieces are in a container in the cupboard in the match room.
- 5) Put down 2 metre marks following the rolling of the green
- 6) Check that the tea urns are positioned full of water and switched on for tea on the run. Check biscuits and milk are available. Ensure enough cups, trays for used cups.
- 7) At the end of play ensure all mats, jacks and golf balls are put away. Clean up tea/coffee area, collect and wash cups. Leave out if needed for afternoon teas, if not return to cupboards
- 8) Return all cards to the 'pool table' in the lounge to be collected by the recorders.
- 9) Ensure that the bar is open at the end of the morning interclub

Role of the Team Manager

If you are appointed Team Manager to an Interclub Team your responsibilities are:

- 1) If the team is playing away enter a time on the selection sheet to meet in the car park prior to the game starting allowing enough time to travel to the visiting club.
- 2) By 5pm two days prior to the game ensure all names have been ticked by the selected team members.
- 3) If names have not been ticked call the club member concerned to see if he/she is available.
- 4) If the player is not available contact the selectors and advise them of the non availability of the player.
- 6) Ensure all team members turn up on the day.

Return all cards to the 'pool table' in the lounge to be collected by the recorders.

7) Oversee and ensure Duty Team does all duties



Conditions of Play for Club Championship 2025/2026

Men & Women

Apart from the usual Conditions of Play that can be found in the Bowls Canterbury Handbook, the Match Committee will need to adhere to the timings for completion of each round. The reason is that the Champion of Champion playoffs have been programmed from 1 February, and the Club Champions will need to be found prior to the corresponding playoff.

Therefore, when entering Club Championship events, all members will be required to play their games as set down by the dates displayed for each event. Substitutes and/or Replacements of players in 'team' events as set down in the Club website, will be approved by the Match Committee.

Any singles player or team that is unable to meet the playing date as set down, must advise the Match Committee ASAP in order to get an extension of time. All valid reasons will be considered, and an extension will be granted if approved. Failure to advise the Match Committee could result in disqualification of one or both opponents.

The following apply to championship events at Burnside:

Skips of Pairs, Triples & Fours teams and Both Singles players are responsible to play on or before the nominated date. If not the Match Committee MUST be advised.

Singles Events

- Open, Under 5, 1&2 Year Men & Women Butterfly System.4 bowls, 21 shots up and a marker is to be used.
- Handicap Singles Men 4 bowls played over 21 ends and a marker is to be used

Pairs Events

 Open and Handicap, Men and Women -Butterfly System.3 bowls, played over 18 ends.

Triples Events

- Open Men 2 bowls, 18 ends, draws count. 4 qualifying rounds, top 8 on wins/draws/differential to championship. All remaining teams qualify for Johnston Plate.
- Open & Drawn Women 2 bowls, 18 ends, Butterfly System Played on Scheduled Days.

Fours Events

- Open Men 2 bowls 18 ends, draws count 4 qualifying rounds, top 8 on wins/draws/differential to championship. All remaining teams to Plate.
- Open Women 2 Bowls 15 ends, Butterfly system.

Mixed Pairs

• 2x4x2 - 14 ends, draws count in section play. Top 8 qualify for championship.

Under 8 Drawn Pairs

• 2x4x2 - 12 ends, top 4 qualify for semi-final and final
