FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- The jack is to be placed on the 2m mark every end. The mat will be moved each end to the appropriate mark. The order to be followed is medium end, short end, long end (MSL) and this is repeated for the duration of the event.
 - The aim is to play 21 ends but this can be shortened if necessary by the organisers.
 - 3 players in each group. 1. Getting ready to play; 2. On the mat; 3. By the jack with the yardstick – the scorer. After number 2. delivers his/her four bowls positions are rotated.
 - i.e.1 goes to2. ; 2. goes to 3. ; and 3. goes to 1. after putting the score on the scoreboard and the pattern is then repeated again and again.
 - **SCORING**
 - **Score by using the yardstick – don't guess! This is to be done AFTER all 4 bowls have been delivered. i.e. don't touch scoring bowls until the player has finished the end.**
 - **At a player's request short bowls can be removed if they are in the road. Any removed bowl cannot score points.**
 - **Short bowls can be promoted into a scoring bowl by being knocked into the scoring zone.**
 - **If the jack is moved it is replaced on the 2m mark. The bowl stays where it finishes.**
 - **Scores must be recorded on the rink scoreboard – record score for each end and the running total.**
- In case of a shortened event 12 ends will be the minimum for a result.

Encourage the other members of your trio. You can indicate how short or long the bowl is.

This game is like playing singles against yourself – you cannot lose! Top score gets the Hayman Trophy.
