Update on COVID precautions at Burnside BC

The Executive is doing what it can to minimise risks to our members while the pandemic continues.

Please get your 'booster' vaccine shot as soon as you are able to do so, and if you are feeling unwell, or have any signs of a cold, stay home!

We support the Ministry of Health's latest recommendations about the wearing of masks to reduce the spread of COVID. We don't enjoy wearing them, but they are now part of our daily lives.

To keep you as safe as possible at Burnside:

- Wear your mask whenever you are in the club pavilion, except for when you are seated for eating or drinking.
- If you go to the bar or the bathroom, masks should be worn – *just as you currently do in a café, bar or restaurant*
- Bar and kitchen volunteers/staff must wear a mask.
- When playing bowls, masks may be worn if you wish.
- We encourage keeping 1 metre distance from others where possible, and not shaking hands before and after play.
- Remember to scan the QR code, or write your name in the register in the foyer, and wash or sanitise your hands to maintain good health.

Umpire's Corner

Question (LXXXII)

Player 'A' plays a running bowl which misses the jack but comes into contact with a group of bowls at the back of the head. The running bowl rebounds from the bank and collides with one of the bowls which is still travelling across the green. What should happen to the bowl that was still moving?

Answer

The skips should place the bowl where they believe it would have come to rest. If they cannot agree, the end should be declared dead. (Law 37.5.2)

Question (LXXXIII)

Having won the previous end, player 'A' delivers the jack which goes straight into the ditch. Player 'B' then delivers a jack in line with the laws. Play continues and the end is subsequently declared dead. Who delivers the jack when the end is replayed?
