National Inter Centre Fixture

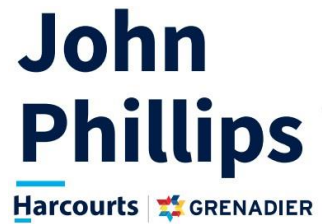
From Lorraine at **Bowls Canterbury**

Umpire's Corner

Question (LXXXVI)

What is the difference between a dead end and a tied end?

Answer

An end can be dead for many reasons, for example when the jack is declared dead in Law 19.1. A dead end should be replayed.

An end is tied if the nearest bowl of each team is either touching the jack or is the same distance from the jack, or if no live bowls are left within the boundaries of the rink in play (jack still live). A tied end is recorded as a completed end. (Law 24)

Following a tied end Law 5.4 will apply.

Question (LXXXVII)

Player 'A' drives at the jack in an attempt to kill the end. The bowls strikes the jack which then comes into contact with an opponent's foot. What should happen?
