
The **Ken Reid Bowls Trophies** were presented by **Rhonda Reid**. A reminder of how much Ken did for the club and how much he is missed.

Umpire's Corner

Question (XCI)

Can a boundary peg be moved if found to be in the wrong position during an end?

Answer

(Law 49.8) If a player or the umpire finds the boundary peg to be in the wrong position, they must not move it until the end has been completed on any rinks affected. The peg must then be correctly positioned by the umpire or by agreement between the skips or opponents in singles on the affected rinks.

Question (XCII)

A Fours game is stopped after the 11th end. It cannot be resumed until three days later.

- a) Are trial ends permitted?
- b) Where should the mat be placed?
- c) Which team delivers the jack?
