### **Carpark safety**

Here's a great opportunity – check your own hearing at Burnside. On Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June, **Bellbird Hearing** will place a **free hearing screening** tool at the club for all members to use for a limited time.

We encourage you to complete a **5 min hearing screening test** which will indicate if you have some form of hearing loss or not. If, following the test, a hearing loss is indicated, Bellbird are offering a **free hearing assessment** ( worth \$85) or **ear wax removal** ( worth \$60) to all members, if required.



Also, the **first 10 people** to make a clinic booking with them and **bring in a friend** for a free hearing test as well, will receive a **\$20 Bakerman's voucher** so they can have morning or afternoon tea following their tests.

Hearing loss can affect not only your hearing in social situations but also your balance, mood, memory and overall quality of life.

If there are extra tournaments more help is needed. For example at the National Championships last January **32 extra shifts** were required and members were **very helpful**, some doing two or three shifts. Thanks!

At the moment we have **lost about 10 volunteers** because of age, poor health and other reasons.

### **Bowls Tactics**

#### Having a Team Plan

Bowls must be the only sport where **tactics** or a plan are not **routinely discussed** before the start of a game.

After the **trial ends** it is useful for the team to have a **short discussion** on the length of end to favour playing and for the leads and seconds to nominate a preferred side.



(Some old school skips would ask the lead and second to bowl on opposite hands believing that it could provide better coverage for building a head.)

About every **6 ends** it is useful to call the team together to discuss progress and whether a **tactical change** is required.

### **Greens Gossip**

**Renovation** work is now **complete** on **Laing**, with our new **Vertacut** machine having been put to immediate use.

**Vertacutting** is the **thinning** of turfgrass by blades that cut perpendicularly to the soil in a shallow swath or a deep cut. This **promotes** lateral and vertical grass **growth**. The cut removes material, i.e. thatch, to allow moisture and oxygen to reach the root zone more easily.

**Laing** has a **solid thatch** layer that restricts moisture and oxygen getting to the roots. Due to the extent of that layer, it is highly likely this green will be **planed** at the end of next season.

**Terry Stewart** has completed the **upgrade** of our two **rollers**, via a gaming grant. This will alleviate ongoing **bearing** issues and associated costs, that occur on a regular basis.

Courtesy of **Martyn's Outdoor Power and Equipment Centre**, a club sponsor, we have purchased a battery powered multi-purpose, trimmer/edging machine. We have over a kilometre of edges around the place and this piece of equipment will save significant time.
