


## The Final Forum from President Brenda

# Till update

Thankyou to everyone who has provided feedback on recent till changes.

#### **Objectives:**

- Running **corporate tabs** on the till will provide a more accurate way of running such a tab. It provides the benefit of a **running total** and allows corporate tabs to be **paid on the night**. Payment of tabs on the night allows money to be in our bank account quicker and **saves** the club the time of **creating invoices** and **chasing of payments**.
- The **Voucher** button creates back of house efficiency by separating it from cash sales.
- **More complete data** will allow several previously unused back of the house systems to be utilized in the future. These include things such as **stock control**, stock taking, stock level alerts and **ordering**, **invoicing** and **accounting**.

#### **Challenges**

The **user interface** proved more **problematic** than anticipated. We heard the feedback about the **number of button** pushes required to sell a single item and difficulties with selling multiples of the same item. **Slowness of the process** was raised as a potential concern on busy nights. Change was also a concern for some with the main barrier seen as being a significant difference from previous logic and the age of the user.

#### Where to from here

Members of the **executive** and the **bar managers** recently **met to discuss** recent changes. From that meeting, everyone agreed to trial an **alternate user interface** that addresses most of the concerns raised above.

The new interface will utilise the tabs at the bottom of the screen and will create 4 main pages, these pages are labelled **Beer**, **Wine**, **RTD** & **Spirits**, **Food**. Each page will have single button presses and the pop up screens have mostly been removed. Beer sales make up around 60% of sales so after each sale is completed, the screen will **default** back to the **Beer** Tab.

**Changes** are best tested and **trialled** in the **off season**. The trial will be for **2 months** with a review after 1 month. These changes are being trialled to provide **enhancements** and **efficiency** to the systems and reduce the manpower labour required behind the scenes and in the back end which keeps the place running. We ask that you **work with us** during the trial to properly evaluate the changes.

To **assist with the changes**, one of the following people will be on site to offer some training when the bar is scheduled to be open. **Derry** Johnston, **Pam** Clarke, **Dave** Wilson, **Hamish** Wilson, **Rod** Kearney.

**Feedback is always welcome** and we invite our volunteers to share their views, experiences and constructive feedback with the team throughout the trial period.



### **Bowls Tactics**

Should I stay or should I go (with apologies to The Clash)

You have **just won the toss**, should you **lay the mat** and deliver the jack or ask your **opposition to do so?** 

- Can you deliver the **jack** to within a **meter** of where you want it?
- Can you deliver your first bowl to within a metre of the jack 80% of the time?
