## **Spotlight on John Reese**

This week we look at the last of our three new life members, **John Reese**. More member bios coming up.

John joined **Burnside in 1987**. Since then he has served over **20 years** on the **executive**, which included two stints as **president** and two as **vice president**. He was **green superintendent** twice, the last time for **ten years** and on his retirement from that job took up **gardening convenor**. He has been **special projects convenor** for five years and was instrumental in getting a **lift** installed. He has been on numerous committees, including the **organising committees** for both **World Bowls** Championships held at Burnside. There is not much that does or does not happen around the club where John does not play a **significant role**.

In his own words here is something about **his life outside of bowls**.

I was born at **Leeston** on the same day as my **twin** brother many years ago. I am one of **ten** children, six girls and four boys. I attended **Sedgemere** primary school which had approximately 20 children and then **Southbridge** District High School. Neither of these schools are there now.

My working career started when I joined **National Mortgage** at **Southbridge** in November 1955 before moving into **Christchurch** in 1958. This was a big move for a lad from the Country.



In 1962 I **married** my wife **Jan** and we moved to **Hawarden** where I was the **Merchandise and Grain agent** for the company. After 6 years we moved to Southbridge then 2 years later into the Christchurch Head office.

In 1973 NMA and Wright Stephenson merged to become **Wrightson**. I was moved to **Waimate** to be the **Merchandise Manager**. This didn't last long as the branch merged with Timaru and I moved to **Timaru** in charge of the branch's Merchandise **Grain and Seed division**.

In **1979** we moved to **Feilding** and while there I was elected to the NZ Grain & Seed Association executive becoming **President** in 1982. I joined the **Feilding Bowling Club**. We moved back to Christchurch Seed Export Division in 1987.

After **42 years** with the company I **retired** in **1996**. In 1997 I was asked to **purchase** the **wheat** for **Champion Flourmills** which I did until **finally retiring** in **2012**.

Jan and I have **three children**, two girls and a boy. Both of our daughters played **netball** and represented **Manawatu**. They both now work in the **health** field helping people with head injuries and other disabilities in **Christchurch**. Michael is married and living in **Melbourne**. He is employed selling eye testing equipment and has a degree in marketing. We are very fortunate to have **four grandchildren**, two in Melbourne and two in Christchurch.

While working in Timaru I was able to purchase a **bach** on **Lake Alexandrina** in the **Mackenzie** basin. I have had it for **40 plus years** and have spent many hours trying my luck in catching mainly **Rainbow Trout**. The bach does not have electricity so there isn't any TV etc but the family really enjoys the **peace and quiet**. They also enjoy the **odd trout**.

## **Greenkeeper Conference**

On the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> June, Jamey Ferris and around 15 other Canterbury greenkeepers attended the South Island Bowls Greenkeepers Conference in Invercargill. 90 Greenkeepers in total from the south island (and a couple from the north) spent the two days listening to various speakers on a range of subjects such as soil testing, disease management, health and safety and some of the old school greens renovation methods lost to time.

**Jamey** was invited to give **two talks**. The first on the My Greenkeeper **training portal** developed by NZ Sports Turf Institute and the National Bowls Greenkeeping Association.



This was the **first time** the new portal had been displayed. It provides a **formal training platform** for newcomers to **learn the art**, and for **volunteers** to learn about tasks such as **mowing** or **rolling**. Participants can gain **certification** after a practical exam. **Jamey** is the **trainer** for the **Canterbury** region and said the feedback was very positive.

The second talk Jamey was involved in was an **open forum** where he, along with two **agronomists**, answered questions from the floor. Jamey says that everybody took something away and had a great chance to **network** and talk about their sites. They hope to all be **better greenkeepers** for their clubs as a result.

### **Bowls Tactics**

#### Shot selection

Choosing a shot is a combination **defence** and **attack**. It's a bit like a chess game **anticipating** and **protecting** against the opponent's next move.


The team **holding shot** has several options:

- adding another shot
- putting a back bowl covering the 2m mark
- moving the jack into a less exposed position
- removing one or more opposition bowls
- blocking an opposition's preferred approach to the head

#### The team **not holding shot** has to decide on:

- drawing to save
- pressing bowls out to reduce the count
- moving the jack to a different position
- killing the end

Both skips need to assess what the opposition is likely to play and the best way to thwart them.



## **Junior Coaching**

**Bowls Canterbury** has changed the name of their **coaching** course for 2022. The Junior Classic is now called the **Open U5's Coaching**, and the Emerging Academy has become **Invitational Development Coaching**.
