

## **Letter from Birmingham**

This report is written with 2 days 17 minutes to go until the Games open!!!

The Games village is **not one single village** but has teams staying at different complexes closer to their competition venues. The **NZ team** is spread across **four sites**. Our bowls team is staying in the **Warwick University** grounds in Coventry. It is all **fenced** off for security reasons and we walk about **7 minutes** to the **dining** hall and **20 minutes** to the **transport** hub. That's a bit of a way to carry bowls bags but airport like luggage trolleys come in useful. The **dining** room is open **24 hours** a day. As you can imagine the menu is diverse and one has to take care not too overindulge. There are also a couple of "**Grab and Go**" tents around the complex which are well stocked with fruit, salads, sandwiches, and drinks and snacks of all varieties. It feels weird to just **walk in**, be given a paper shopping bag, **load up** and **walk out!**!

The bowls team was the **first group** to arrive at our complex and we were honoured to be **welcomed** with our **NZ Team Haka** on our arrival. With that process we became part of the Tangata Whenua so we are now **part** of the **welcome group** and **Haka** party as other **Kiwis arrive**. We have been privileged to welcome the NZ **Judo** team and the Women's and Men's **Rugby Sevens** teams. It was very special when both the Sevens teams **responded** to the **Haka** challenge with their **own Haka** and **Waiata**.

The **volunteers** have been **friendly** and gracious and ensure we have everything we need. The **security** is significant with the police and private security companies ensuring we are all safe. We understand that the **total security force** for the games equates to about the **size** of **half** of the **NZ police force**.

We had our **first two days practice** at the local **Wellesbourne** Bowling Club It was great to get on the **11 second green** and shake off the **jet lag** cobwebs.

We then moved on to the **headquarters** greens at **Leamington Spa**. All teams are able to book **3 or 4 rinks** for **three hour** practice **sessions** on a **daily** basis. There are **five greens** side by side. The finals green is surrounded by **high grandstands** on two sides and an enormous **ty screen** on another.



The greens are all running 11/12 seconds which is manageable given our preparation on croquet lawns and similar. All rinks play differently with some **straighteners** around the place. It is critical to **read the green early**. Having **5000** noisy **spectators** will be something else to **adjust** to.

A **practice match** was played against **South Africa** today. The vision impaired and para women did not play but the open men's and women's pairs and triples and men's para pairs did. The **results** were **not** as we **wanted** with only the para men having a convincing win and the four open sides all registering close losses. On **Tuesday** another **practice match** will be played against **Wales**.

The bowls team will **not be attending** the **Opening** Ceremony on **Thursday** due to our team responsibilities around **Covid**. We wear **masks** at all times, **inside** and **out**. The open and para events will start on **Friday** with the vision impaired starting on **Sunday**. Not surprising but everyone is getting a little bit excited.
