
### **Bowls Tactics**

### A bowl has come to rest on the jack

If you are **down**, **accept** that you're not going to **get the shot back** with **1 bowl**. It's a 2 or even a 3 bowl plan.

- **Draw** a bowl **behind** if you haven't already got one.
- **Broaden** the **target**. Draw a bowl in close proximity. The perfect spot is **30cm short** and **30cm wide** of the jack
- Play a weighted shot aiming for your wing bowl. An inside or outside edge could dislodge the jack or the toucher. Hitting your wing bowl square could produce a result while a bowl narrow of the wing bowl may hit the target directly.

You shouldn't fall into the **trap** of trying to **dislodge** the touching bowl with **each** of your bowls. If you **miss**, your bowls will end up **out of position** and you may go down a number of shots.


