### **Bowls Tactics**

### **Forcing Shots**

Forcing shots need to be **practised** in **game** situations. You'll **miss plenty**, but with time they will be **very effective**.

Every bowl reacts **differently** due to their **configuration** and also your **delivery**. You need to know what **combination** of **speed** and **green** is required for different shots. You just have to **play a lot** of them to get the feel. A **wider** drawing bowl will **go around** short bowls, a **straighter** bowl might go **underneath** them.

Skips will often ask for a **2 metre** shot **through** the head to remove bowls. Take into account the **speed** of the **green**. Slower greens will need **more force.** You want the bowls you hit to be **removed** not **just moved** 1 metre.
