## **Executive Summary**

**Key points** from the **Executive** meeting of Tuesday **18**<sup>th</sup> **October**.

- Club maintenance: Members of the Executive will meet on 30<sup>th</sup>
   October to assess and prioritise maintenance projects.
- **Photocopier/Computer**: Thanks to **Duane Smith** (Manager of Ricoh), we will have a **new photocopier** delivered in the next week or two. We have a **computer** set up in the **Men's match room** for members to enter competitions online or check out the website.
- **Greens:** We have applied for a **grant** through Mainland Foundation to assist with funding a new **computerised sprinkler** system. **Laing** green requires significant **maintenance** over the **winter** months and a **plan** will be drawn up so as to **minimise disruption** at the start of the 2023/24 season.
- **Membership: 266** members (57 non-playing). We have **9 new** members (7 first years) mostly as a result of the **open days**. WELCOME ALL.
- **Club lighting:** We are **replacing** lighting in the upstairs lounge and adding **dimmer** switches to create more ambience, along with lighting up some of the darker areas of the club.
- **Life Members board:** This will be relocated to the **top** of the **stairs** to the lounge. We feel their names should be displayed in a more **prominent** location.
- Bar: We are introducing a 2-for-1 deal (on occasions) so we don't get caught with expired stock. Reminder: Our club license does not allow us to sell alcohol to members to "take away".
- **Corporate Bowls/ Hire of club:** We have had 46 enquiries for premises hire, and year-to-date, **39 groups** have booked with **1142** players. **Alan Bryce** continues to do an **outstanding** job.
- Catering for evening interclub: A new trial. The catering
  volunteers will prepare the food timed for the end of the games. The
  host team will take the food upstairs and clean up afterwards.
- Club chemicals: To improve safety, we will follow chemical safety
  guidelines and provide Material Data Sheets for appropriate
  chemicals that outline use and safety recommendations.
- **Mats and jacks trolleys:** These have now found a new home **under the stairs**; please ensure you return them to this area after use.






















# Orchard Trophy: This Saturday

The Hotline is getting **snaffled**, by **xtra's** aggressive new rules, as **suspected spam**. We are **working** on getting xtra to **change** this but in the meantime there are things **you can do**.

The most **reliable** way of getting your Hotline is directly off the <u>web page</u>. There is a **button** under the rotating sponsors' logos. The Hotline will be there by **midday Thursday**.



#### **Links and Attachments**

I'm hoping to **avoid** sending an **attachment** (which is contributing to the problem). This week I have **only sent a link** to the Hotline. This might not suit everyone immediately so **get in touch** if you want to continue getting an attachment (with its associated risks of going into to spam).

#### **Xtra Customers**

If you are **not** receiving the Hotline you are probably **not receiving** other emails and **might not** even **know**.

#### What you can do:

You can **prevent this problem** by adding email addresses to your **xtra contacts** (not phone contacts). **You need** to do this on the **xtra web page**. Here is a <u>handy guide</u> from Rotary.

If you need help (e.g. **forgotten** your **password)** then you can request a <u>support call back</u> from Spark. They usually get back to you within an hour. You will need your Spark account number.

### What we are doing:

I did **eventually persuade** xtra to fix the problem but a week later they promptly **unfixed** it. Many thanks to **xtra** user **Richard Mitchell** who is experimenting to find the precise conditions wrongly triggering the email as spam. He will then make **another case** to **xtra**. This is a recurring issue affecting many organisations.
