Interclub Matters (from Mike Small for Selectors and Team Captains)

The posting of **teams on-line** has been in place for a **couple of years** now. Last year with AJ's help, we were all able to tick our name on-line either in **black** if going **via the club** or playing at home and in **green** if going **direct** to the away club.


The Post Christmas competition earlier this year saw a **further change** where the selectors had the **capability** of loading the **next round** of teams **direct to the website**. The team sheets were and still are displayed on the wall in the match room. This has **created additional work** for the **selectors** and also the **team captains**, because they are required to check **both** the **on-line** and **match room** copies to ensure that the teams are complete.

Many players are **very good** at ticking their name. However some players **continually need chasing** by the team captain to make sure they are playing. We have some who tick on-line (this is preferred), some who tick on the sheet in the match room **and sadly some who don't tick at all** to confirm they are playing without being chased. This creates **unnecessary work** for team captains.

I'm therefore asking that **all members** involved in **interclub** make an effort to **tick your name on-line early**. Teams are usually posted around **5 days prior** to the date. Here's how its done:

From home or your mobile device

- 1. Go on line to the bowling club web site https://www.burnsidebowlingclub.com
- 2. Select the **inter-club tab** at the top of the page.
- 3. Select the **event** you have elected to play in.
- 4. Click on the **empty tick box** next to your name and a tick should appear in 'black'. If you have an **away** game and are **traveling directly** to the venue please **change the tick to 'green'**.



At the Club

- 1. There is a **computer** in the corner of the **match room** where the draws are normally pinned.
- 2. If the screen is **blank** give the **mouse a shake** to wake it up. You should then see either the **inter club home page** or team sheets.
- 3. If it is one of the team sheets you see but not the one you want (someone else has been there doing the same thing but in a different competition or team) click on the **Burnside tab** at the **top left** of the screen.
- 4. Follow steps 3 and 4 above (from the at home instructions)

The selectors and team captains are asking that you **get familiar with the on-line process** because the team sheets will **NOT** be posted in the match room from the start of the **Post-Christmas** competitions in **2023**. If you are uncertain how to do this, **please ask a friend** to assist.

Keep Healthy and Safe over the Summer

Our first responder, **Kylie Joy**, has been keeping the **first aid kits** replenished and has the following **advice** for staying well in what is likely to be a **very hot** summer.

- 1. In the first aid kit in the women's locker room there are now glucose tablets for anyone who is experiencing hypoglycaemia (low blood sugars). There are quite a few diabetics in the club, and giving them fast acting sugar when they are feeling faint, may stop them from becoming very sick very quickly. These tablets are chewed and do not need to be dissolved in water (they are raspberry flavoured).
- 2. Remember to **hydrate** and eat plenty of **carbohydrates** when you are playing. In the **first aid kits** there are **cooling towels** which you run under cold water and put around the neck. There are also **plenty of ice packs**. This can reduce the incidence of heat exhaustion or **heat stroke**.
- 3. Kylie is part of a St John trial of a personal **portable AED**. If she is at the club and someone has a **cardiac arrest**, then she would **like to use** the portable AED rather than the clubs AED. The **trial AED is extremely useful** and has a great rate of success in reviving patients prior to the ambulance service arriving on scene.
