## **Inter Club Scorecards (Important)**

Bowls Canterbury have recently had issues with **scorecards** being **completed** and **signed incorrectly** - usually with the **scores** written in the **wrong column** under the **wrong names**.

The Bowls Canterbury **Umpires Association** have **discussed** this issue **comprehensively** and have issued this statement:



- **Skips** are responsible for keeping the score card for their game, and for signing it at the completion of the game.
- Once the **score card** is **signed** by **both skips** and handed to either the umpire or the
  controlling body, it becomes the **official record** of the game and stands as the final
  result of the game.
- In future, if both the skips sign a card that has an **incorrect result**, which is then handed in to the umpire or the Controlling body the **score card result will stand as the final result** and will **not be amended**.

Please, please always double check your cards before signing them!

### **Course for Markers**

It's **been a while** since our last marking course and several **newer members** are already stepping forward to help the club. With the upcoming **National Inter Centre tournament**, Burnside will be headquarters for the whole operation and expected to field a **quality team** of **markers** with **considerable numbers** required.


### **Thank You from Bowls Canterbury**
