Bar Price Increases

From 1st April 2023

In January, the club was notified of price increases from Lion Brewery and KiwiGas, effective from the end of February 2023. Due to Lion Brewery being our biggest supplier and the size of the price increases (as high as 8%), a review of pricing was undertaken on all products. The results were a recommendation to increase the following:

- **Tap beer** (including Guinness) to increase by **\$0.50 cents** per handle and \$1.00 per jug
- **RTD:** Jim Beam RTD, Canadian Club RTD, Gordons Pink Gin & Soda RTD to increase by **\$1.00**
- **Soft Drink:** Ginger beer, Lemon Lime & Bitters, orange juice to increase by **\$0.50 cents**
- **Pump water** bottles to increase by \$1.00.

Corporate pricing on the above to increase by the same amount.

Pricing on **all other items** is to remain **unchanged**, although it was noted that, with inflation running at 7%, **price increases** from suppliers were likely to be **more frequent**. In particular, it was noted that **wine pricing** was **vulnerable** to any future cost increases.

The **Executive agreed** to adopt the above price **recommendations** from 1st April 2023, noting that it was carrying **good stock levels** to cover the month of **March**.
