### **Keith McFarlane**

It is with much sadness that we must record the passing of **Keith McFarlane**, one month into his **ninety - second year**.

Since **joining** at the start of the **1989/90 season**, Keith became a **well respected member**, and a **highly regarded player** at our Club.

Keith's bowling career was very interesting. He was **nineteen** years of age when he was sent to the **Sanitorium** at Waipiata in Central Otago to **recover from T B**. It was during his **three and a half years** there that he **started** playing lawn **bowls**.

His occupation as a **Livestock Agent** resulted in a number of transfers, and he probably played in **at least five Clubs** before becoming a member with us here at **Burnside**. This range of playing environments no doubt contributed to his **ability to play at a high level**, no matter what the conditions.

It was only in the last year or two that age started to catch up. Prior to that, he was a **deadly draw player** on either hand; could **play the yard-on shot** removing their shot bowl and dead draw with his next one. He could also play a **run-shot**, not blasting, but deadly accurate. He also had an ability to **read and build a head**.

My own special memory of playing with Keith was, with Wing King as lead, **winning the Club Championship Triples in 2007**, and progressing well through in the Centre C of C's.

That made me think about that old maxim - the **80 % / 20 % ratio**. In this case, Wing and I contributed 20 % and Keith 80 %!

Would I sooner play with him or against ? - no doubt at all.

Some of the **best advice** that he gave me? If I was **bowling narrow**, as some of us do, when changing ends, as we passed he would quietly say, "**look at your feet**". Think about it.

Apart from his bowling skills, the other thing I admired him for, was his manner in being **humble in victory** and **gracious in defea**t. (I guess a good lesson for all of us).

We will miss you Keith
