Spotlight on Pam Clark

Pam was born and bred in **Dunedin** where her **parents played bowls** at North East Valley. Her brother, **Stewart Buttar**, was a magnificent bowler. Winner of several **National Championships** and a **New Zealand rep and coach**. He played for Burnside until his death in 2006.

Pam did **athletics** and played **basketball** as a youngster and **represented Otago** in **softball** for a number of years. She worked for a **public accounting** firm as a **credit controller** then as a **cashier receptionist**.



She **married George** and then moved to **Christchurch** when he got a job with Lane Walker Rudkin. **George had played bowls** at Wakari Bowling Club, Dunedin, and after moving to Christchurch played at **Burnside**. They had **two daughters** (one our own lovely **Tracy Wilkinson**) and **6 grandchildren**. Pam got a job at **Medbury school** and stayed there for **17 years**.

When George died Pam **took up bowls at Burnside** and collected **18 club titles!** She was in **Junior and Senior Canterbury representative teams** for a number of years. With the encouragement and guidance of **Cushla McGilvray** she became a **coach** and was coach/selector of the **Canterbury development team** for 7 years. One of her highlights was **coaching the team to a win** in the **National Intercentre** competition in 2016.

Outside of bowls and her grandchildren Pam has managed to do **some travelling**. She has made two trips to the **United Kingdom** and **Europe**, one on her own and the other with an old school friend from Dunedin. She has also enjoyed some **cruises** around the **Pacific** and **Mediterranean** and made frequent trips to **Australia** to see family and have holidays in **Coolangatta**.

Still an **excellent bowler**, Pam is mostly just playing for **enjoyment** now.
