Spotlight on Arjan (AJ) Van Hasselt

AJ is the **guy in orange**! He is a regular around the club, often behind his **camera** or **managing** the data at **tournaments**. He is behind the development and continual expansion of the **Tournament Management System** that **produces cards** and **maintains results** for everything from **festival bowls** to the **Burnside Pairs** and more! It is **used in several clubs** around the country. Responsible for **many things in IT** he developed and maintains the **club's web page**, manages the **slide shows** and **electronic notice boards** and is happy to make **house calls** for members with IT problems.

And of course the Ken and AJ Super Saturday tournaments.

Here is a bit more about his life.

AJ's parents arrived in New Zealand from the Nederlands in 1951 and he was born in 1954 at Thames maternity hospital.

In **1959** the family **went back** to the Nederlands for a year. AJ s**tarted school there** and **learnt Dutch** before returning to Thames.

In **1963** they moved to **Tokoroa** in the middle of the North Island where he finished intermediate and high school.

This was where **his interest in photography** began. He **started** a photography **club** and took **action photos** at the school **sports days**. He organised the **Miss Tokoroa High contest** and used the **profits** to build a **dark room** and **enlarger** for printing photos.



While at school AJ **played hockey** and was selected for the **New Zealand Secondary team** for two years running . He then went to **Otago University** to study **physics** and gained a **B.Sc**. In 1975 he did a one year teaching course at **Christchurch training college**, and **married Clare**.

He **taught at Hamilton Boys** for two years and then migrated south to Dunedin where he taught Physics, Science and Maths at **Bayfield High**. He studied **Tai Chi** for several years and it helped relieve the stress of teaching.

In 1985, AJ left teaching to become a trainee computer programmer at Cadbury Schweppes Hudson. It was here he learned to eat chocolate for morning and afternoon tea, and started his jogging career. He joined Cardinal Network in 1987 and then in 1989 moved to Christchurch to join the LINC Development Centre. Here he taught programmers how to build systems using the LINC fourth generation language.

In **1995**, he was made redundant and left the company for six months before returning to what was now the **JADE Software Company**. He **taught JADE** to kids, university lecturers and business IT people. The job took him to **Australia**, **USA**, **Singapore** and the **UK**. He was involved in developing a **mortgage application** for HML in Skipton, **Yorkshire**.

In 2019, AJ decided that 65 was a good age to retire and leave the programming to the youngsters. His first retired task was to join a walking group. His watch tells him he

walks about **1900** km each year. He also joined a Friendship club and started reading, especially **science fiction**.

While in Dunedin AJ **played bowls** for about a year with his father-in-law and took it up again in **1992** after damaging his achilles tendon. He played in the **Burnside Pairs** twice with the late **Mike Sykes**. He enjoys meeting people from other clubs and especially likes the **Manning Cup.** He has tried his hand at **directing a blind** bowler, and won a **silver medal** for directing **Spencer Stacy** in the **2020** National B3-B4 Singles.

While AJ was overseeing the **JADE kids**, they developed the beginnings of the **Bowling Tournament Management system**. This was first used for the **Burnside Pairs in 1996**.

He continues to develop the system and has recently developed a feature that allows players to update game results on their cell phone and send them back to the office. He also built a **google sheets** application for **Bowls Canterbury** to record and display interclub results.

He built the club **Website in 2003**. It is a wonderful resource, containing a huge amount of information and history. AJ is constantly adding features (such as being able to enter tournaments on line).

AJ has a **daughter** with a Master of Fine Arts degree and a passion for the colour orange, and a **son** who coaches the New Zealand 3x3 basketball team and lectures at Canterbury University. He has **two grand girls** who keep his mind challenged and he enjoys doing arty type projects with them.
