Some thing we should all understand re Law 23 and 31

Law 23 Improper delivery of the Jack

For all Inter-Club / Championship Events Law 23 will apply

If a player improperly delivers the jack the opposing player should place the mat and re deliver the jack.

If the jack has been improperly delivered by each player the jack shall be placed on the 2 metre mark by the first player to play.

However for Time Limit games eg Mid Week Tournaments an experimental law is in place whereby if there has been one improper delivery of the jack the opposing Skip may direct the lead where to place the mat then place the jack in a legal position on the centre line.

In addition for "Time Limit" games Law 31

If any end is declared dead after the time limit bell has gone it shall be counted as an end played

We reconfirm the experimental laws do not apply to Centre /National or Championship events and apply only to
Non Championship Time Limit Events
